I regret that I will not be able to attend the public hearing next Monday but I would be grateful if you would use this written comment:

I am sure many Semiahmoo residents appreciate as much as I do, the excellent work being carried out by the Blaine Public Works Dept., in keeping the grass verges very well mowed on Semiahmoo Parkway.

Regrettably, about the same number of residents, are concerned that no action has so far been taken to repair the Bike/Pedestrian Path which runs alongside this road.

For the record, I have now twice taken representatives from the Public Works Dept., on tours of this pathway and have pointed out the dangers the many holes present, for those who use it. The first time was about five years ago and the most recent in the last two years. This last representative spray painted the really bad areas. Both representatives have now left the department.

I do not understand how the six-year program operates but I think it is long overdue that attention has not been paid to repairing this path. All of us are getting older and more likely to fall on this pathway. I hate to think that something very serious has to happen before funding can be allocated to this project. Please advise.
