I am writing this letter in support of granting the Community Assistance Program Conditional Use permit request. I have volunteered at the clothing bank for a number of years with my mother and view their services as a wonderful community asset. The amount of services that are provided by the Community Assistance Program and listed on the City of Blaine website is a great testament to how essential this organization is to our City and community. Finding CAP a permanent home to stabilize where church and essential social service information is located to help provide for our residents has been a long time coming.

The building use will still be consistent with prior use, as they still will be holding church services on site. I don't believe that the additional, essential help provided by the social programs that would be run from the building, for less than 10 hours, on 3 non consecutive days per week, would generate enough traffic to disrupt the neighborhood.

I have read the other letters of support provided by the local church leaders and cannot add any additional words of support, only echo them, and express the appreciation of the services CAP provides to our local community. The services provided from a G street location are nothing different than what they are currently doing from multiple local churches and seems to my untrained eye to be consistent with what is expected a local church to provide its' local community on any day of the week. Granting the conditional use permit for CAP helps all the local churches by being providing a consistent location for all essential services to be received by our local residents.
