PERMIT CONDITIONS

The City reserves the right to revoke this permit if the work does not conform to the following permit conditions. Any work performed prior to revoking the permit will be repaired, stabilized, and/or replaced at applicant's expense.

1. All work must be performed in accordance with the City of Blaine development standards. (www.cityofblaine.com)
2. The City Public Works department must be notified 24 hours in advance of any construction.
3. Where street closure is involved, a diagram of traffic control, detours and signage must be submitted prior to issuance of this permit
4. This permit becomes null and void if the work or construction authorized is not started within 180 days or if construction or work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days at any time after work starts.
5. Contractor is subject to a 12 month warranty from the date work is completed to ensure adequate backfill, base, and surface has been installed in the right-of-way.
6. This permit is not valid until permit fee is paid.
7. The work must be performed by a licensed contractor or the legal owner of the above described property.
8. All privately maintained/owned utilities in the public right-of-way shall be relocated at the applicant/owners expense upon written notice from the City.
